Question 4:

A company, **BLUE LAGOON LTD**, which develops software, cannot find people with the appropriate skills in the local area. It decides to offer teleworking contracts.

(a) (i) What is teleworking?

Teleworking involves carrying out work away from office and communicating with the employer by using computer and telecommunications equipment.

(ii) Give two ways in which teleworking could help the company in this situation.

- It may tempt better staff to come and work for the company
- Travel-related problems may be reduced, example, staff being unable to get work due to rail /road delays.

(b) **BLUE LAGOON LTD** is planning to place an advert on the Internet which will highlight the advantages of teleworking to employees.

(i) Give two advantages of teleworking to employees.

- No commute and no travel costs
- Work around their family's needs

(ii) Give two disadvantages of teleworking to the company.

- Employers need to be able to trust their staff and be prepared to have less direct control over them
- There is no face to face communication between the employer and the employee.

Question 5:

The diagram below shows a computer monitor in sleep mode.



Give 2 ways to 'wake up' the computer monitor. Method one

- Method one: Press the SLEEP keyboard shortcut.
- Press a standard key on the keyboard.
- Move the mouse.
- Quickly press the power button on the computer.



Method two

To wake up a computer or the monitor from sleep, move the mouse or press any key on the keyboard. If this does not work, press the power button to wake up the computer.
