Adverbs – Form and Function

Adverbs are words which modify the meaning of a verb. Adverbs can also modify adjectives and other adverbs.

Example:

- She speaks quickly.

In the example above, "quickly" is an adverb which modifies the verb "to speak". The adverb is used to express the way in which the subject speaks.

Grammatical Rules

1. The general rule for forming adverbs is to add the termination "-ly" to an adjective.

Examples:

- honest → honestly
- 2. For those adjectives that end in "-y", the "y" becomes an "i". The termination becomes "-ily."

Examples:

```
-easy\rightarrow easily
```

3. For adjectives which end in "-ic", the termination changes to "-ically".

Examples:

```
automatic → automatically
```

```
tragic → tragically
```

4. For adjectives that end in "-le", the "e" is dropped and the termination "-ly" is added.

Examples:

```
terrible \rightarrow terribly
```

incredible \rightarrow incredibly

5. Some adverbs don't change. The adjective and adverb are the same.

Examples

-hard

-fast

Function of Adverbs

Remember: As we have seen, *adjectives* tell us something about a noun (person, place or thing).

Adverbs, on the other hand, tell us something about the way in which something is done. Adverbs can modify verbs, adjectives or other adverbs.

Examples:

Verb

- Miguel <u>runs</u> **fast**.
- You speak loudly.

Adverb

- He runs **really** fast.
- You speak **very** <u>loudly</u>.

Adjective

- I am **very** <u>happy</u>.
- She is **really** <u>nice</u>.
