Fundamentals of Software package -Teleworking – Week 1

Teleworking also known as telecommuting means working from home or alternative location using information and communications technologies (ICTs) instead of the office. Jobs can therefore be relocated to places where it is more attractive more convenient or cheaper to live.

Advantages for the employer

- 1. No need to provide employee with a computer or furniture if they choose to use their own.
- 2. Office running costs and overheads (rates, electricity, heating...) can be reduced which in turn may reduce the need for office space.
- 3. Travel –related problems may be reduced that is workers being unable to arrive at work on time due to road delays.
- 4. Improved motivation with reduced levels of stress and absence due to illness.



Disadvantages for the employer

- 1. Increased costs from providing computer equipment and telecommunication links for teleworkers.
- 2. More difficult to manage teleworkers and monitor their performance.
- 3. Increased risk to the security of the information that is used by teleworkers.
- 4. Employers need to be able to trust their staff and be prepared to have less direct control over them. It is therefore harder to check if the workers are doing their work properly.

Advantages for the employees

- 1. Provides a better balance between work and family life.
- 2. No travel costs or time wasted travelling to and from work
- 3. They can work in the comfort from their own home.
- 4. The employee can work for a company situated hundreds or even thousands of miles away from his home

Disadvantages for the employees

- 1. May lack the self-discipline to work unsupervised from home.
- 2. A teleworker may feel isolated because they miss the social interaction from their colleagues at work.
- 3. May be unable to work effectively because of distractions in the home environment.
- 4. May not have the space at home to provide a suitable environment for teleworking.
