

a) Define the term Networking.

b) Give 2 advantages of networking

Adv 1: Data can be easily backed up and stored on file server

Adv 2: Reduce cost by sharing hardware (example, a printer or scanner) and software (example, using a network version or site license of a program)

c) Give 2 disadvantages of networking.

Disadvantage 1: The hardware, software and expertise required to set up a network can be expensive.

Disadvantage 2: If the server fails to work the complete network may also fail to work.
