The life and death of Iqbal Masih

Iqbal Masih from Pakistan was just four years old when he was sold by his parents to a carpet factory owner. Iqbal worked for more than 12 hours a day in the carpet factory, and was often chained and beaten.

At the of 10 Iqbal's life changed completely when he attended a human rights meeting and heard about children's right for the first time. He stood up and gave a speech which was later printed in the papers. Afterwards he refused to his "owner" and obtained his freedom.

Iqbal went to struggle for the rights of other children and encouraged them to fight for their rights.

In April 1995, Iqbal Masih was shot dead while riding his bicycle. He was just 12 years old. His killer have never been found.
