What is Multimedia

Multimedia that uses several forms of <u>information content</u> (e.g. <u>text</u>, <u>audio</u>, <u>graphics</u>, <u>animation</u>, <u>video</u>) to <u>inform</u> or <u>entertain</u> the <u>audience</u> (User). Multimedia also means the use of electronic <u>media</u> to store and experience multimedia content. Multimedia means that computer info can be represented through audio, graphics, image, video and animation in addition to traditional media (text and graphics).

Advantages of Multimedia Technology
