

- b) Name the 3 main parts of the central processing unit and state the function of each one.
 - Memory or Storage Unit: The computer can manipulate only data that is in main memory. Therefore, every program you execute and every file you access must be copied from a storage device into main memory.
 - Control Unit: The control unit is a component of a computer's central processing unit that directs the operation of the processor. It tells the computer's memory, arithmetic and logic unit and input and output devices how to respond to the instructions that have been sent to the processor.



3. ALU: This unit consists of two subsections namely,

Arithmetic Section

Function of arithmetic section is to perform arithmetic operations like addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division. All complex operations are done by making repetitive use of the above operations.

Logic Section

Function of logic section is to perform logic operations such as comparing, selecting, matching, and merging of data.

Q5: Define the following terms used in Word Processing

- i. **Paragraph Formatting**: Paragraph formatting is a change of the format of text that affects the complete paragraph or is different from other paragraphs in a document. For example, indenting the full paragraph.
- ii. **Cut and Paste:** To insert the copied/cut text into a different area of the document, a different document, or an entirely different application altogether, right-click and select paste. The use of cut, copy and paste is not necessarily limited to text.
- iii. **Scroll Bar:** A bar that appears on the side or bottom of a window to control which part of a list or document is currently in the window 's frame. The scroll bar makes it easy to move to any part of a file.
